MONTHLY BILLING INCREASES 23% IN JULY

- An additional 7.54 GWh has been signed in the month of July 2016 to commence billing
- Represents a 23% increase in a single month, compared to the previous monthly increase rate of 9%
- LPE is billing 39.34 GWh, an increase from 31.8 GWh from 30 June 2016
- Substantial operational progress driven by strong pipeline conversions

Locality Planning Energy Holdings Limited (ASX: LPE) (the Company) is pleased to inform shareholders an additional 7.54 GWh in billing contracts through the month of July, representing a 23% increase in a single month.

This is a significant increase on the Company's previous monthly increase rate of 9%. LPE now has 39.34 GWh of billing contracts, as of 31 July 2016, up from 31.8 GWh as at 30 June 2016.

This increase is attributable to an increase in the conversion of sites from the Company's contracted pipeline to sites under management and therefore billing, as well as a number of direct to billing communities coming on line.

Director and Chief Executive Officer, Damien Glanville states; "The contracts under billing through the month of July are a result of continued momentum in building and converting our pipeline and importantly, reflects our ever improving deployment processes. We look forward to continuing to grow our revenue earning volumes in the months to come."
